This indenture made this 2nd day of January 1726 between William P. Ervitt of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the one part Rebecca J. Jones of the same County and State of the second part &
James Rockelle of the County and State of Virginia of the third part Witness there as a marriage party
intended to be had and solemnized by the permission of God by and before us the said William P.
Ervitt and Rebecca Jones and witness the said Rebecca J. Jones is possessed of a certain small
tract of land and parcel and also entitled to a proportion of the said said Estate of her said
father Allen Jones and whereas it hath been agreed that the said William P. Ervitt should after
the said intended marriage have us and enjoy during the joint lives of them the said William P.
Ervitt and Rebecca J. Jones the enjoyment and occupation of the whole Estate of said which the
said Rebecca J. Jones may be entitled to in any way whatsoever and that upon the death of either party
the said William P. Ervitt or the said Rebecca the whole and every part of the said said shall go and pass
absolutely to the issue or issue of the said William P. Ervitt by the marriage to be shortly between
them and in the event of no such issue to the here in saying however to the survivor of them and in
the said event in the event of death of one and she has been expressly agreed by and between the
