 the said William P. Everett during the joint lives of the said William P. Everett and Rebecca T. Jones
 his widows wife to have and enjoy all the interest and profits of the said property hereby conveyed
 to and for his own use and benefit and him and after the decease of each of them as he shall happen to
 die first leaving no issue of their marriage then in trust that the said James Roddell his Executors
 administrators and assigns shall and do assign transfer and pay over all the said property to the said Rebecca
 in her own right in case the survivor the said William P. Everett but if the survivor here
 leaving no issue of their marriage at the time of her death then that he the said James Roddell his Executors
 administrators and assigns shall and do assign transfer and deliver all the said property to the said William P. Everett
 in his own right and it is furthermore particularly and expressly agreed between the parties to
 these presents that the said James Roddell his Executors administrators and assigns shall at the request of the request

 February 1826. This Indenture as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings of the aforesaid

This Indenture made this 19th day of January in the year of our Lord 1826 between Joseph Pope (parties)
 of the first part William Pope heretofore of London now deceased of the second part and Augustina
 Pope of the third part who were the said Joseph Pope on the 22nd day of November 1822 in order
 to secure and save them self Augustina Pope as the security to the debt on due to Perry Walker
 and the other due to Matthews Peen due by indenture of trust of that date coming to the said
 Joseph Pope his heirs of the following property to wit one certain tract or parcel of Land situate being the
 said and plantations whereon the said Joseph Pope resided at that time containing one hundred
 and forty seven acres he the said Pope and his heirs as on the said deed of that date expressed
 upon Trust for the uses and purposes in the said indentured mentioned and whereas since the
 Executing & delivery of the said deed of Trust the said William Pope hath fully satisfied the
 said debt aforesaid which is hereby acknowledged Now this Indenture witnesseth that her
 the Considerations aforesaid as well as for the further and better of the said one certain
 in Land paid by the said Charles Coffin to the said Joseph Pope and before the
 on calling and delivery of them presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 of the said Joseph Pope with the agent & preparation of Augustina Pope signified
