 to secure and save them self Augustus Pope as the security to the debt on due to Pringle Walker
 and the other due to Matthews Brown did by indenture of that date convey to the said
 Joseph A. his heirs of the following property to wit one certain tract or parcel of Land situate being the
 Land and plantation whereon the said Joseph A. resided at that time containing one hundred
 and forty seven acres he the said Joseph A. or his heirs as in the said deed of that date expressed
 upon Trust for the use and purpose in the said indenture mentioned and whereas since the
 Executing and delivery of the said deed of Trust the said William P. Everett hath fully satisfied the
 said debt aforesaid which is hereby acknowledged Now This Indenture witnesseth that for
