 third part all of the State of Virginia Witnesses being present at the said Ennith and Bland both the
 day become bound as security for William P. Ennith for the sum of two thousand dollars
 in a note or bond payable to John Thomas as administrator of Henry Jopier by due and due
 months from the date thereof being the same day and date in which there presents and the
 said William P. Ennith being desirous to secure and save himself from the said Edward B.
 Bland from all damage which he may be liable to sustain by reason of the said security
 aforesaid both agreed to carry out him to the said Andrew Middleton and do by their presents
 truly grant bargain sell and carry unto him the following property to wit truly further
 his and furniture all of his lands, lots and together hereto the house and on negro man
 named Andrew T. here and to hold the aforesaid property unto him the said Andrew Middleton
 as Trustee aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns upon this special trust and Confidence that
 is to say in Case he the said Edward B. Bland shall at any time become himself in danger
 of suffering by reason of this said security that he the said Middleton at the request
 of either of the parties shall after giving to any duly notice of the same and place held
 at the most public place in this County before to bid the aforesaid property for cash
 in the Town of Jamestown and out of the proceeds thereof first pay and satisfy the aforesaid
 demand or sum of two thousand dollars with all reasonable costs and charges attending there
 presents as well the accruing interest thereon should there be any due to the said Edward
 B. Bland or any other persons whom it may hereunto and the surplus of any pay
 over to the said William P. Ennith or to his order or to any other person or persons by him
 assigned to receive the same until which time he is expressly and solely by and between the
