This Indenture made the 27th day of December in the year 1825 between William Fowler & Martha his wife of the first part and Matthew Guiley of the other part all of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia witnesseth that the said William Fowler and Martha his wife for the consideration of the sum of One hundred and Eighty Eight dollars and twenty nine cent to them or their uses, and by the said Matthew Guiley also before the Enacting and dater of this present instrument the receipt whereof above fully acknowledged they the said William Fowler and Martha his wife have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Matthew Guiley his heirs or assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County and marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a large wood tree a corner on said boundary line 125 E 3/4 pole to an old rock stump one Gunner corner thence north 85 W 5 poles to a sum Henry Corp and four Gunners corner thence N 52 W 6 1/4 pole to a gun Edwards Gunner corner thence S 37 W 1/2 pole to a small Spanish Oak a corner on said Corp thence N 52 W 4 1/4 pole to a pine a corner on said Corp thence N 23 E 2 1/2 poles to a small stone sum a corner on said Gunner and of Henry Corp thence along said boundary line 125 E 1/4 pole to the beginning containing thirty six and more or less one fifty three and a half acres of person land adjoining the Land of Harry Corp Edin' Gunner together with all buildings the appurtenances thereon and personal property belonging and otherwise unto you and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof To have & to hold the said tract or parcels of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Matthew Guiley his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Fowler and Martha his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Fowler purcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Matthew Guiley his heirs and assigns free from the claim or demand of whom the said William Fowler and Martha his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatever they the said William Fowler and Martha his wife have heretofore let their Land and lease the day and year as aforesaid above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of
