To all Christian People to whome this present Writing shall come Richd Vick of the County of Southampton in Virginia send Greeting Know ye that I the said Richd Vick for divers good causes and valuable Considerations me hereunto moving have given granted and by these presents do give grant and Confirm unto my Son Joshua Vick of Southampton County aforesaid all my Lands on the South side of Nottoway River that is not already Willed away and half that Survey of Land which I purchased of John Gent and all the Raisd Hoggs of mine that shall be found on the South side of Nottoway River aforesaid and seven teen beds of Cattle small and grown & likewise four Negroes known by the names of Chance, Patten, Rachel & Maria To have and to hold all and singular the said Promises whatsoever of me the said Richd Vick unto my said son Joshua Vick his heirs & assigns from hence forth to his and their own Proper use and uses thereof and therewith to do order & dispose at his or their will and Pleas as of their own proper rights & Titles free and peaceably and quietly without any manner of Lett Trouble or Denial of me the said Richd Vick or
