 This Indenture made the 13<sup>th</sup> Day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred & fifty four Between Richard Vick sen<sup>r</sup> of Southampton County of the one  
 part and William Vick of the s<sup>c</sup> County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Vick  
 for and in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in  
 hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> William Vick the Receipt whereof the said Richard Vick sen<sup>r</sup> doth hereby  
 acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened Infeoffed and Confirmed and by  
 these Presents doth grant bargain sell alien Infeoff and Confirm unto the said William Vick  
 his heirs and assigns forever one Certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County  
 of Southampton aforesaid containing by Estimation one Hundred and fifty acres let the same be more  
 or less and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a pine on the North side of the  
 Cyprus Swamp then <sup>seventy degrees West</sup> South seventy four pole to a pine then South thirty Degrees west Ninety  
 eight Pole to a gum by the side of the Cyprus Swamp aforesaid and down the various Courses of  
 the Run of the said Swamp to a gum at a corner tree standing in the Edge of the Cyprus Swamp aforesaid  
 then by a line of marked trees Crossing the Survey to the beginning with all trees Woods  
 Underwood Common Commons of Pastures Profits Commodities advantages Emoluments  
 Hereditaments whatsoever to the Plantation or Tract of Land belonging or in any ways  
 appurtenant or or Upon the same growing happening or arising and also the Reversion  
 Reversion Remainder and Remainders Tents Services of the premises and every part  
 thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of him  
 the said Rich<sup>d</sup> Vick sen<sup>r</sup> of in or to the same Premises and every part thereof To have  
 and to hold all and singular the said Premises above mentioned and every part  
 thereof with the appurtenances unto the said William Vick his heirs and assigns to  
 the only proper Use and behoof of the said W<sup>m</sup> Vick his heirs and assigns forever and the
