

Trustees thereby appointed were Impowered & Authorized to make sale of all or any part of their Circular Tract of Land of Six Miles Diameter situate on the North side of Nottoway River in that part of the County of Isle of Wight which is now Southampton and after any agreement made for the sale of any part of the said Land so as such part should not exceed four hundred Acres to any one person it should be lawful for the Chiefmen together with the said Trustees the Survivors or Survivor of them to seal & Deliver Deeds of Feoffment & to make Sivery of Seisin upon the Land to be Indorsed upon such Deed to the Purchaser who immediately after the Execution thereof should pay Down to the said Chiefmen the Purchase Money for which a receipt should be likewise endorsed on the Deed and after any Feoffment so Executed & Acknowledged or proved by the Oaths of three Witnesses and Recorded in the said County should be sufficient in Law to pass the fee simple of such Land to the Purchaser thereof and Whereas the Chiefmen of the said Nation did sell unto the aforesaid Samuel Blow party hereto part of the said Tract of Land but before any Deed for the same was Executed unto the aforesaid Samuel Blow party and to the Directions of the Above Recited act of Assembly the Trustees therein appointed died by Reason whereof the Title of the said ^{Samuel Blow} is Defective and whereas by act of Assembly made in the twenty fifth year of his said present Present Majesties Reign Intituled an act to Conform the Title of Lands purchased of the Nottoway Indians & for other purposes therein mentioned It was amongst other things enacted that the Chiefmen of the said Nottoway Indians should be impowered by and with the Consent of ^{Edheldred Taylor} Robert Jones the younger & Joseph Gray Gent Surviving Trustees thereby appointed to seal and Deliver a Deed or Deeds Indented to any person or persons who had purchased any part of the said Land according to the Directions of the above Recited act and such Deed or Deeds being Acknowledged or proved by the Oaths of three Witnesses in the General Court or the County Court of Southampton and Recorded should be as effectual in Law to pass the fee simple Estate of such Land to the Purchaser thereof as if the same had been made and Executed by & with the Consent of the said John Simmons Thomas Locke & Benjamin Edwards Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Sam. Dock. Tom. Wat. Barley, John Furner, Tom. Turner, Jack Will, George Scipper & Harry Chiefmen of the Nottoway Indian Nation aforesaid by and with the Consent of the said Edheldred Taylor Robert Jones & Joseph Gray Surviving Trustees as aforesaid and also for and in Consideration of the sum of fourteen Shillings & three pence to them in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged have granted Bargained sold infeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell Infeoff. and Confirm unto the said Samuel Blow his heirs and assigns fifty seven acres parcel of the said circular tract of Land Bounded as followeth To wit, Beginning at a Hickory a corner of Samuel Blows Land in Thomas Chappells line thence along the Chappells line 563 pole to a Hickory a corner of Benjamin Vassers Land thence along Vassers line 109 pole to a black oak & 115 pole to a Hickory a corner of Vassers Ben. Eburns Joseph Grays thence along Grays line 127 pole to a white oak a corner of Samuel Blows Land thence along Blows line to the beginning as by the Survey and Plat of Robert Jones Gent Surveyor of the said County of Southampton doth appear and all the Estate Right Title and Interest of the said Nottoway Indians in and to the same To have and hold unto the said Samuel Blow his heirs and assigns forever

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
