This Indenture made the Twenty third Day of April In the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred & fifty four & in the Twenty seventh year of the Reign of our Lord King George the second Between John Wolts of Surrey County & Thomas Wolts of James City County of the one part & James Barham of the County of Southampton of the other Part Witnesseth that for & in Consideration of the sum of Thirty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to the said John Wolts & Tho. Wolts in hand paid by the said James Barham at & before the sealing & Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof they doth here by acknowledge & there of Acquittance and Discharge the said James Barham his heirs & assigns Admonors they the said John Wolts & Tho. Wolts hath granted Bargained Sold Aliened Released Enfeoffed & Confirmed & by these Presents Doth grant Bargain sell Alien Release Enfeoff & Confirm unto the said James Barham his heirs & assigns forever all that Tract or Parcel of Land Containing by Patent One hundred acres be the same more or less lying & being on the South side of Walloway River in Southampton County & Bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a point in the North side of the Three Creeks thence North West One hundred & Twenty Poles to a Hickory then South Seventy Degrees West Sixty seven poles to a pine then South Sixty five Degrees West forty nine poles to a Oak then South South East fifty eight poles to a pine a corner tree of James Sammons Land then by Sammons line South East Seventy four poles to a pine then East South East twenty two poles to a gum by the side of the Three Creeks aforesaid and Down the various Courses of the run of the said Creeks to the beginning which said Tract or Parcel of Land was granted by Robert Carter Esq<sup>r</sup> President unto John Wolts by Letters Patent bearing date the fifteenth Day of June One thousand seven hundred & Twenty seven and all Houses Out Houses Edifices Buildings Yards Gardens Orchards Woods Underwoods &c.
