This Indenture was proved by the Oaths of William Wernack John Dray & John Lundy
the Witnesses hereto and Ordered to be Recorded Test J. Wells Clk

This Indenture made the seventh Day of August In the Twenty eighth year of the
Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France
& Ireland King Defender of the Faith & so forth and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand
seven hundred and fifty four Between William Wommock of the parish of Nalloway in
the County of Southampton of the one part & Thomas Wommock of the same Parish & County
son of the s^d W^m Wommock of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the natural Love Love & Affection which the s^d William hath for & beareth the s^d Tho^s
he the s^d W^m hath given granted Aliened & Confirmed by these presents both Give
Grant Aliend & Confirm unto the s^d Tho^s Wommock his Heirs & Assigns forever Eighty four
acres of land lying & being in the s^d Parish & County on the North side of Mecherin River it
being a Tract or Parcel of Land granted to the s^d W^m by Patent bearing Date the thirtieth
Day of May One thousand seven hundred & thirty five and Bounded as followith To wit
Beginning at a white Oak near Walls Branch a corner of the s^d W^m Wommock's other Land
thence North fifteen Degrees West sixty eight Pole to a white oak thence North by East
one hundred & eight Pole to a pine near a branch thence south sixty Degrees East Ninety
three Poles to a red oak thence South fifteen Degrees East Ninety Pole to a light wood post
in a line of the s^d W^m Wommock's other Land & thence by his own old line south seventy
Degrees West one hundred & Twelve Poles to the Beginning With all & singular the appurte-
nances thereunto belonging or in any wise appurtenant To have & to hold the s^d Eighty
four acres of Land be the same more or less & premises to him the said Tho^s Wommock his heirs
& assigns forever to the only use and behoof of the said Thomas Wommock his heirs & assigns for-
ever and to & for no other use Intent or purpose whatsoever In Witness whereof the s^d W^m
Wommock hath hereunto set his Hand & affixed his seal the Day & year first above mentioned
