the said Benjamin Clifton for and in Consideration of the sum of sixteen Pounds
Current Money of Virginia to the said Benjamin by the said John in Hand paid before
the sealing & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof the said Benjamin
doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed
and by these Presents for himself & his Heirs doth Clearly and Absolutely Grant Bargain
sell alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said John Bradley his Heirs and Assigns all that
Tract or Parcel of Land Situate Lying & being in the County of Southampton on the North
side of Nottoway River containing One hundred & Ninety acres and Bounded as followeth
to wit Beginning at a White Oak a corner of Robert Rich's Land Thence North thirty
Degrees East Seventy seven Poles to a White Oak Thence North Sixty five Degrees East
Twenty nine Poles to a small Black oak in Lazarus Joyner's Line Thence by the s^r. Joyner's
lines North Sixty five Degrees West Fifteen Poles to a White oak North Twenty Degrees
West one hundred & Seventy four Poles to three Trees Chopped inwards North fifty five Degrees
East Twenty three Poles to a pine Thence North five Degrees East Twenty Poles to a pine in W^m
Hearns Line Thence by the said Hearns's lines North seventy Degrees West forty eight
Poles to a white oak South Seventy five Degrees West forty three Poles to a white oak
