This Indenture made the seventh Day of April in the year of our Lord one  
 thousand seven hundred and fifty five Between William Jenkins and Mary his wife of  
 Southampton County of the one part & Henry Crafford of the County aforesaid of the other  
 Part Witnesseth that the said W<sup>m</sup> Jenkins and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the  
 sum of Ten Pounds of good and Lawful Money of Virginia to them in Hand. hath granted  
 aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoffed  
 confirm unto the said Henry Crafford and his Heirs forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land being  
 part of a patent granted to Elias Braddy bearing Date one thousand seven hundred & forty  
 seven and bounded as followeth viz. Beginning at a beach on the south side of Meherrin  
 River thence down the River to a blackberry on the said Rivers bank aboerner Tree of Joshua  
 Dawson's Land thence along the said Joshua Dawson's Line to a Red Oak in the old Line of Elias  
 Braddy's Land thence along the said line to the County line thence along the County line to  
 the first Station. With all Trees Woods Underwoods Common Commons of Pastures Profits  
 Commodities Advantages Emoluments and Thereditaments whatsoever to the Tract of Land  
 belonging or in any ways appertaining or upon the same growing happening or arising  
 and also the Reversion, Reversions, Remainders & Remainders Rents & Services of the  
 Premises and every Part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said  
 Premises abovementioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances  
 unto the said Henry Crafford his Heirs to the only proper use and behoof of the said  
 Henry Crafford and his Heirs forever and the said William Jenkins & his wife Mary the  
 said Lands and premises abovementioned and every part thereof against them and their Heirs  
 and against all and every Person or Persons whatsoever unto the said Henry Crafford his Heirs  
 and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these Presents In Witness whereof  
 the said W<sup>m</sup> Jenkins and Mary his wife have hereunto set their Hands and affixed their seals  
 this Day and year above written
