This Indenture made the Ninth Day of February in the year of our Lord One
 Thousand seven hundred & fifty four Between Joseph Lark & Ann his Wife of the County of
 Southampton of the one part & Timothy Thorp of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
 that these Joseph Lark & Ann his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of nine pounds ten
 shillings Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the s^d. Timothy Thorp before the
 dealing and Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the s^d. Joseph Lark & Ann his wife doth hereby
 acknowledge hath granted Bargained & sold & doth by these presents grant Bargain and
 sell unto the s^d. Timothy Thorp his Heirs and assigns forever: a certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying
 being in Southampton County aforesaid and on the west side of Plowman Swamp containing by
 Estimation one hundred and five acres be the same more or less: Beginning at a pine
 Corner of Thomas Johnsons Land thence North West to a white Oak on Plowman Swamp & thence
 thence running up the s^d. Swamp to a pine in the mouth of the Huckleberry branch; thence
 up the various Courses of the turn of the s^d. Branch to a red Oak a corner tree in the old line
 thence East to the first Station And the Reversion & Reversions, Remainder & Remainders
 Rents Issues & Profits thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim & Demand
 whatsoever of them the said Joseph Lark and Ann his wife and their Heirs of in or to the same
 or any part thereof to have & to hold the s^d. Land and premises with all and singular the
 Appurtenances thereunto Belonging unto the s^d. Timothy Thorp his Heirs & assigns forever
 To the only proper use and behoof of the s^d. Timothy Thorp his Heirs & assigns forever and these
 Joseph Lark & Ann his wife for themselves their Heirs Executors and Admors doth Covenant promise
 & grant to and with the s^d. Timothy Thorp his Heirs and assigns by these presents that these
 Joseph Lark and Ann his wife their Land & Premises and every part and parcel thereof unto
 the s^d. Timothy Thorp his Heirs and assigns against the lawful Claim Title and Demand of the
 said Joseph Lark and Ann his wife and their Heirs and all and every other person & persons
 whatsoever shall and will warrant & forever Defend by these presents In Witness whereof
 the s^d. Joseph Lark and Ann his wife hath hereunto set their Hands and affixed their seals
