 hereby Acknowledge and him self therewith to be fully satisfied Contented and paid shall
 Given granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Released Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these
 presents the said Thomas Johnson for him self and his Heirs forever doth give grant
 Bargain sell Alien Release Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Henry Applewhaite and
 to his Heirs and Assigns forever one tract or Parcel of Land Containing seventy Acres
 Situate lying and being on the three Creeks on the North side in the Southampton
 County aforesaid and is Bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a poplar on the
 South side of the Little Plowmans Swamp and running Southwest to a Red Oak and from
 thence South East Course to a White Oak and from thence running North East Course to
 a Spanish Oak and from thence running up the said Swamp or North West Course to
 the aforesaid Poplar to the Beginning together with all Houses Buildings Orchards
 woods ways Waters and Appurtenances to the Land belonging or in any wise appertaining
 and all the Estate Right Title Interest Property Claim and Demand whatsoever of the said
 Thomas Johnson of in and to the same and every or any Part thereof and the Reversion
 and Reversions Remainder and Remainders thereof and of every Part and Parcel thereof
 thereof which said Bargained and Sold Lands being Granted to the said Thomas Johnson by
 Patent Dated the twentyfourth Day of October In the year of our Lord one thousand seven
 hundred fifty two Reference being thereunto had will more fully Appear and is the
