

Between the Parties to these presents that if the said Robert Ricks or any Person or persons for him do and shall well and Truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Michael his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns the full and just sum of three hundred & forty six pounds three shillings and one penny half penny on or before the twenty Day of July One thousand seven hundred and fifty six with Lawful Interest thereupon without any Manner of Abatement Default or Delay whatsoever that the said Robert Ricks shall and may be Possessor of the said hereby granted Slaves as if this Deed had never been made and it is further hereby agreed between the parties to these presents that the said Ricks shall and may be in the Possession and have the use and benefit of the hereby granted Slaves until default be made of the Payment of the sum aforesaid In Witness whereof the Parties to these presents have set to their Hand & Seals this Day and year aforesaid.

This Indenture made the thirteenth Day of November in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & fifty five Between Samuel Bafo & Elizabeth his Wife of the Parish of Albermanle in the County of Sussex on the one Part & Thomas Briggs of the Parish of Southwark in the County of Surry of the other Part Witnesses that the said Samuel Bafo & Elizabeth his Wife for and in consideration of the full & just sum of One hundred & forty pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in Hand paid by the said Thomas Briggs the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge & themselves to be therewith fully & intirely satisfied Hath given granted, bargained sold Alien released & confirmed by these presents Doth give grant bargain sell Alien release & confirm unto the said Thos. Briggs his Heirs and Assigns for ever One certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton on the North side of the three Creeks between the two Plowmans the great Plowmans & the little Plowmans Swamp containing one hundred & ninety Acres which said tract or parcel of Land was granted to Samuel Bafo as appears by Letters Patent bearing Date the twenty third Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty three & by him conveyed to the said Thomas Briggs, bounded as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a poplar on the North side of the little Plowmans Swamp thence North five degrees East one hundred & twenty eight Pole to a white Oak thence North seventy four Pole to a gum by the side of Great Plowman Swamp thence up the various courses of the Run of the said Swamp North eighty Degrees west seventy Pole & North sixty Degrees west forty eight Pole to a pine thence south west by west seventy Pole to a small Hickory thence south twenty Degrees west ninety Pole to a pine by the side of the little Plowmans Swamp aforesaid & down the various
