This Indenture made this tenth Day of September in the twenty ninth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c And in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred & fifty five Between Richard Kirby & John Kirby both of Southampton County of the one part and Moody Kirby of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Kirby & John Kirby for and in Consideration of the Rent of one year of Indian Corn to be paid upon the feast of Saint Michaelmas the Arch Angel by the said Moody Kirby to them the said Richard Kirby & John Kirby they the said Richard Kirby and John Kirby hath given granted bargain & leased unto the said Moody Kirby the lands and plantation whereon he now dwells Containing One hundred Acres with all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Moody Kirby his Heirs & assigns during the Natural Life of him the said Moody Kirby and his wife Tammy Kirby and they the said Richard Kirby & John Kirby for them and their Heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with the Appurtenances above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof against them and their Heirs Heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever the said Moody Kirby his Heirs and assigns shall and will Warrant and Defend during the term aforesaid In Witness whereof they the said Richard Kirby & John Kirby hath hereunto put their Hands and Seals the Day and year above written

This Indenture made the eleventh Day of November In the twenty eighth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred & fifty four Between John Hoines and Elizabeth his Wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Hoines of the County of Sussex of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Hoines & Elizabeth his Wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of twenty five Pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in Hand paid by the said Thomas Hoines at or before the sealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said John Hoines and Elizabeth his Wife do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain & sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain & sell alien onfeoff release & confirm unto the said Thomas Hoines his Heirs & assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing by Estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the Parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton aforesaid and on the West side of a Swamp called & known by the
