 to him in Hand paid by the said William Jackson the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
 to the said John Edwards hath granted bargained Aliened and Confirmed and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell alien and Confirm unto the said William Jackson his Heirs and Assigns forever
 all that Plantation tract or Parcel of Land lying and being on the North side of Meherin River
 in Southampton County Containing by Estimation One hundred Acres be the same more or
 less and bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a White Oak Standing near Whiteheads Road
 then Southwest sixty pole to a hickory then south fifty Degrees East - forty pole to a Dogwood then
