This Indenture made the twelfth Day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty six Between John Kirby of the Parish of Nettoway & County of Southampton Planter of the one Part and Benjamin Bosman of the said County Planter of the other Part Witnesseth that the said John Kirby for and in Consideration of the Sum of Seven pounds to him in Hand paid at or before the Enrolling & Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath Granted Bargained Sold aliened Enfeoffed & Confirmed and by these Presents doth grant Bargain sell alien Enfeoff & Confirm unto the said Benjamin Bosman and to his Heirs & Assigns forever One Parcel or tract of Land situate & being in the Southampton County aforesaid & containing fifty Acres by the same more or less Bounded as followeth And lies on the South side of the Kussock Swamp Joining Joshua Heines Land & the said Benjamin Bosman Line To have and to hold the said fifty Acres of Land with the Appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Bosman his Heirs & Assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the Benjamin Bosman his Heirs & Assigns forever yealding & Paying unto his Majesty his Heirs & Successors the Yearly Quitrents due for the said Land and the said John Kirby doth for him self & his Heirs further Covenant & agree with the said Benjamin Bosman his Heirs and Assigns that the said John Kirby his Heirs &c shall & will Warrant and forever Defend the above Mentioned Land and Premises unto the aforesaid Benjamin Bosman his Heirs & Assigns against the Claim of all and every Person and Persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said John Kirby hath hereunto Put his Hand and Seal the Day & year above Written Sealed & Delivered In presence of }
