Beginning now this Indenture Witnesseth that the Chief Men of the Indian Nation with the consent and Approbation of their Trustees (Testified by their being made Parties to these presents for and in consideration of the Sum of Sixty five pounds thirteen shillings secured to be paid as aforesaid) Have granted Bargained & sold aliend enfeoffed released & confirmed & by these presents do grant Bargain & sell aliend release enfeoff & confirm unto the said John Thomas his Heirs & Assigns seven Hundred & eighty three Acres part of the said Tract of Five thousand of Land as above to be sold and also the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents & Services thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Property Claim and Demand whatsoever of the said Nation & their Posterity of in & to the same To have and to hold the said seven hundred & eighty three Acres of Land with the Appurtenances unto the said John Thomas his Heirs & Assigns to the only proper Use & Behoof of the said John Thomas his Heirs & Assigns for ever In Witness whereof the said Chief and Trustees have hereunto set their Hands and Affixed their Seals the Day & Year First above Written.

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This Indenture made this Thirtieth Day of January in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of our sovereign Lord King George the 3^d Now King of Great Britain France & Ireland Defender of the faith &c in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven Hundred & Fifty Seven Between William Row of the Parish of Notoway in the County of Southampton & Martha his Wife of the one Part & William Dun of the County of York of the other Part Witnesseth that the said William Row & Martha his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty four pounds ten shillings Curr^t Money of Virgin^a to the said W^m Row in hand paid by the said W^m Dun at or before the sealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt Whereof the said W^m Row doth hereby Acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said W^m Dun have & each of them in &c hath granted Bargained & sold Aliend enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant Bargain sell, sell Aliend enfeoff & confirm unto the said W^m Dun & to his heirs and Assigns for ever all that Tract or Parcel of Land Situate Lying & being in the aforesaid Parish of Notoway & County of Southampton on the North of the Mill Swamp containing one Hundred Acres
