This Indenture In part like made the Eleventh Day of January in the  
 Thirtieth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Graces of God of  
 great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c & in the Year of our  
 Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and fifty seven Between Sam<sup>l</sup> Robt<sup>t</sup> Scholar  
 Skiper Jachs Will John Turner & Tho<sup>s</sup> Steps Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation of the  
 first part Joseph Gray William Taylor & Howell Edmunds Gent: of the County of Southampton  
 of the second part and John Underwood of the County of Southampton of the third  
 part Whereas by an Act of Assembly made in the twenty ninth Year of the Reign  
 of his present Majesty intituled an Act to enable the Nottoway Indians to sell certain  
 Lands and for other purposes therein mentioned. The Chief Men of the said Nottoway  
 Nation were impowered with the consent and Approbation of the said Joseph Gray  
 William Taylor and Howell Edmunds the Survivors or Survivor of them Trustees  
 therein named to see the said Act duly executed to sell at a Credit not exceeding  
 twelve Months and convey as well about three hundred Acres of low ground part of their  
 Tract of Land of six Miles square lying between the western Boundary of their Tract  
 of Buckhorn Swamp on the south side of Nottoway River in the County of Southampton  
 as that part of their Tract of Land lying between the said Swamp & the south side
