The sale of the same or any part thereof it is by their Act Declared lawful for the chief Men of the Nation together with their Trustees Afores^d or the Survivor or Survivor of them to seal and Deliver any Deed or Deeds intended for the Conveyance of the premises and inheritance of the said Lands to the Purchaser upon his entering into Bond with good Security for the payment of the Purchase Money to the Trustees for use & purpose in this Act Express'd And whereas the R. William Pope^r for the Consideration of forty four pounds ten shillings (for the paym^t whereof to the said Trustees for the use aforesaid he hath entered into Bond with good Security) hath purchased two hundred & sixty one Acres part of the said Tract of five thousand Acres of Land of the said chief Men of the Indian Nation with the Consⁿ & Approbation of the said Trustees Bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Hickory a corner of N^E 11 in the Indian Backline running along the^s line North forty five Degrees East one hundred and Seventy four poles to a Hickory in the^s line thence North forty five Degrees West two hundred & forty poles to a pine south forty five Degrees West one hundred & Seventy four poles to another pine of south forty five Degrees East two hundred & forty poles to the Beginning Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said chief Men of the Indian Nation with the Consent & Approbation of the Trustees Testified by their being made parties to these pres^t for and in Consideration of the said sum of forty four pounds ten shillings Secured to be paid as afores^d Have granted Bargained & Sold aliened enfeoffed Released & Confirmed by these presents Do grant Bargain & sell alien enfeoff release and Confirm unto the R. William Pope his Heirs and Assigns the^s two hundred and sixty one Acres part of the^s Tract of five thousand Acres of Land as above to be sold of all other Prevision and Provisions Remainder & remainders rents & Services thereof & also all the Estate Right Title Interest Property claims and Demand whatsoever of the Indian Nation or their Heirs or in and to the same To have & to hold the^s two hundred and sixty one Acres of Land with the Appurtenances unto said William Pope his Heirs & Assigns to the only proper use & Behoof of the R. William Pope his Heirs & Assigns for ever In Witness whereof the said chief of Trustees have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals the Day & Year first above written
