

Act to enable the Nottonway Indians to sell certain Lands & for other purposes therein mentioned the Chief Men of the said Nottonway Indian Nation were empowered with the Consent & Approbation of the said Joseph Gary W^m Taylor & Horrell Edmunds the Survivors or Survivor of them (Trustees therein named to see the said Act duly executed to sell at a credit not exceeding twelve Months & convey as well about three hundred Acres of low ground part of their Tract of Land of six Miles square lying between the western Boundary of their said Tract & Buckhorn swamp on the south side of Nottonway River in the said County of Southampton as that part of their said Land lying on the east side of the said swamp and the south side of Buckhorn Road to the Eastern and Southern Boundary thereof containing about five thousand Acres for the best price that could be got & after any Agreement made for the sale of the same or any part thereof it is by the said Act Declared lawfull for the Chief Men of the said Nation together with the Trustees Aforesaid or the Survivors or Survivor of them to seal and Deliver any Deed or Deeds indented for the conveyance of the fee simple and Inheritance of the said Lands to the purchaser upon his entering into Bond with good security for the payment of the Purchase Money to the said Trustees for the use and purpose in the said Act expressed & whereas the said Arthur Foster for the consideration of forty five pounds two shillings for the payment whereof to the said Trustees for the use aforesaid he hath entered into Bond with good Security hath purchased two hundred and forty six Acres part of the said Tract of Five thousand Acres of Land of the said Chief Men of the said Indian Nation with the Consent and Approbation of the said Trustees Bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a white Oak on the west side of Buckhorn swamp in the Edge of the low grounds a Corner of Number four running along the line of Number four South ten Degrees East three hundred and eighteen poles to a black Jack standing on Barrons Road thence up the various courses of the said Road to a Corner Pine thence North thirty Degrees West ninety eight Poles to a pine in the Chincheypen Branch thence down the Meanders of the said Branch to a white Oak in the Edge of Buckhorn swamp aforesaid & down by the edge of the low grounds of the said swamp to the beginning now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Chief Men of the said Indian Nation with the Consent and Approbation of the said Trustees (Testified by their being made parties to the said Deed) for & in consideration of the said sum of forty five pounds two shillings secured to be paid as aforesaid Have granted Bargained & sold aliened enfeoffed Released & confirmed & by these presents Do grant Bargain & sell alien enfeoff Release & confirm unto the said Arthur
