 This Indenture Tripartite made the Eleventh Day of January in the thirtieth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c and in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & fifty seven Between Sam. Robt Scholar Skipper Jack Will John Turner & Tom Steph Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation of the first Part Joseph Gray W^m Taylor & Howell Comunds of the County of Southampton Gent: of the second Part W^m Turner Junior of the third Part of the County Whereas by an Act of Assembly made in the twenty ninth Year of the Reign of his present Majesty intituled An Act to enable the Nottoway Indians to sell certain Lands & for other purposes therein Mentioned The chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation were impowered with the Consent and Approbation of the said J. Gray W^m Taylor & Howell Comunds the survivors or Survivor of them Trustees therein named to see the said Act duly executed to sell at a Credit not exceeding twelve Months and convey as well about three hundred Acres of low ground part of their said Tract of Land of Six Miles Square lying between the western Boundary of their said Tract and Buckhorn Swamp on the south side of Nottoway River in the said County of Southampton as that part of their said Lands lying on the east side of the said Swamp & the south side of Buckhorn Road
