 Hill Swamp containing One Hundred Acres part of a Patent Granted to William Edwards
 bearing the 16th Day of June 1714 And Bounded as followeth Beginning at the Mouth
 of the Old Field Branch & up that Branch to Jesse Jones Line then Jesse Jones Line to Joseph
 Vasson Line then Vasson Line to a Small Branch just below Cumbs Old Field and down
 that Branch to Susannah Branch & down that Branch to the Beginning and the
 Reversion and Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rent to Issues & Profits thereof
 and the Estate Right Title Interest Claim & Demand whatsoever of him the said
 John Caum & his Heirs of in or to the same or any Part thereof To have
