Edmund This Indenture made this Tenth Day of February in the Thirtieth Year of the  
Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain & France  
Emperor of Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between Howell Edmunds Junr. of the County of  
Northampton in the Province of North Carolina of the One Part & Howell Edmunds  
of the County of Southampton in the Colony & Dominion of Virginia of the other part witnesseth  
that the said Howell Edmunds Jr. for & in Consideration of the sum of One hundred & Seventy three  
Pounds One Shilling Current Money of Virginia to the said Howell Edmunds Jr. in hand paid by  
the said Howell Edmunds the Receipt whereof the said Howell Edmunds Junr. do hereby acknowledge  
they the said Howell Edmunds Jr. have granted & sold Aliend & Confirmed by these Presents  
do grant Bargained and sell Aliend & Confirmed unto the said Howell Edmunds his Heirs &  
Assigns forever three Seats Tracts or Parcels of Land situate lying & being on the West Side  
of Nottoway River in the County of Southampton containing by estimation Nine Hundred  
& Eighty two Acres The first Tract contains two hundred & Ninety four Acres & bounded  
as followeth to wit beginning at a live Oak a corner tree in Blunts swamp at the Mouth of  
the Deep Branch thence up the Meanders of the said Branch to a corner Red Oak on Barren  
Road thence down the various Courses of the said Road to a tree standing on the road on  
the head of Blunts Swamp aforesd. and down the said swamp as it meanders to the  
beginning The second Tract or Parcel of Land contains Three Hundred & Sixty Nine  
Acres & bounded as follows Beginning at a live Oak in Blunts swamp a corner of N<sup>o</sup> 7  
running up the Meanders of the said swamp to White oak a corner in the said swamp thence S 25 E 15
