This INDENTURE Inparte made the Eleventh day of January in the thirtieth year of the
reign of our sovereign Lord King George the second by the grace of God of Great Britain France &
Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between sam Robt. Molar Shiper Jack Will Jr & Turnery
and Howell Edmunds of the County of Southampton gent of the second part of William Pope Junr.
grfs Neck of the County of Southampton of the third part Whereas by an Act of Assembly
made in the twenty ninth year of the reign of his present Majesty intituled "An Act to enable the
Nottoway Indians to sell certain Lands for other purposes therein" the chief Men of the Nottoway
Nation were empowered with the Consent and Approbation of the S^d Joseph Gray W^m Taylor
& Howell Edmunds the Survivor or Survivor of them Trustees therein named to see thes^d Act duly executed
to sell at a credit not exceeding twelve Months of convey as well about three hundred Acres of Land
part of their Tract of Land of Six Miles Square lying between the western Boundary of the
said tract & Buckhorn swamp on the south side of Nottoway River in the County of Southampton
as that Part of their Land lying on the east side of the said swamp and the south side of Buckhorn
Road to the eastern and southern boundarie thereof containing about five thousand Acres for the
best price that could be got and after any Agreement made for the sale of the same or any part
therof it is by thes^d Act declared lawfull for the chief Men of the Nottoway Nation together with the Trustees
aforesaid or the survivors or Survivor of them to seal and deliver any Deed or Deeds indentured for the
Conveyance of the fee simple of Inheritance of thes^d Lands to the purchaser upon his entering into bond
with good security for the payment of the purchase Money to thes^d Trustees for the use of purpose in the
Act expressed if whereas thes^d W^m Pope for the consideration of eleven pound sixteen shillings Current
Money for the payment whereof to thes^d Trustees for the use aforesaid he hath entered into bond with
good security that he hath purchased two hundred and fifty two Acres part of thes^d Tract of five thousand
Acres of Land of thes^d Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation with the Consent & Approbation of the said
Trustees bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a Hickory at corner of Number twelve in the
Indian Back line running along said line North East One hundred seventy four poles to a black
Gum in Coves Branch & in said Indian line thence up the Coves Branch as it Meanders to a Red
Oak in thes^d Branch thence along a line of Marhaw Trees North forty seven Degrees West one hundred
thirty four poles to a Red oak south West one hundred sixty six poles to a pine south East two
hundred forty poles to the Beginning Now this Indenture witnesseth that thes^d Chief men of the Nottoway
