This Indenture made this ninth day of May Anno Dom: One thousand seven hundred & fifty seven between Arthur Taylor of Edgecombe County in North Carolina and Thomas Turner of Southampton County in Virginia Witnesses that the said Arthur Taylor for & in Consideration of the sum of Fifteen pounds Current Money to him in hand paid have given granted bargained sold Alien enfeoffed & Confirmed and by these presents doth give Grant Bargain & sell Alien enfeoff Transfer & forever Confirm unto the said Thomas Turner his heirs & Assigns for ever a parcel of Land containing Ninety Acres or thereabouts part of a patent bearing date the twenty fourth of January One thousand seven hundred & fifty six & bounding as follows beginning at a Red Oak Then North seventy Degrees West One hundred & Twenty poles to a Lightwood stump Then North ten Degrees West thirty Eight poles to a pine Then North eight Degrees West thirty Eight poles to a Gum Then South West thirty One poles to a Hickory & a pine Then South ten Degrees East one hundred & seven poles to a Lightwood stake in the said Arthur Taylors Other Land Thence by his Own Line South Seventy degrees East eighty two poles to a Pine then a long a New Line of Chopit Trees which was agreed upon by Harris Taylor & Thomas Turner to the first beginning To have & to hold the said Ninety Acres of Land to the

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
