 Maple standing standing in a marsh in or near Thomas Obbrys Line from thence running up
 the Various courses of the Run of a Swamp called the Cypress Swamp till it strikes John
 Barneys Line from thence along the ^d Barneys Line till it strikes Timothy Drahers Line from
 thence along Drahers Line to a Branch from thence down the Various Courses of the Run
 of the said Branch to the first Station To Have and to Hold all & singular the ^d Land
 and Premises with the Appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the ^d Thomas Fisher his Heirs Executors
