And the said W^m Kitchin, Joseph Cumm, Patience Taylor, Henry Thomas, James Godwin, Matthew, Godwin & Thomas Minton for themselves & their heirs do hereby warrant & defend the Negro Slaves before bargained & sold unto the said Richard Cooke & his heirs, Coors, Assigns or Assigns against the Claim & Demand of all & every Persons & Person whatsoever. In Witnes whereof the Parties to these presents have hereunto set their Hands & seals this first Day of January one thousand Seven Hundred & fifty Seven.
