Now Court held for the County of Southampton the 14th Day of July 1757
This Indenture of the Memorandum of Sundry of Sundry therein endorsed were proved by the Oaths of John Bryant James Fowler & Lazarus Johnson Witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded And Martha the wife of the said Thomas personally appeared in Court & being first privately examined as the Law directs Voluntarily relinquished her Right of dower In the Estate conveyed by the said Indenture Test



This Indenture made the tenth Day of January in the Year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred & fifty seven Between Richard Beul of the County of Southampton of the one part & Benjamin Beul of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Beul of Mary his wife for & in consideration of the sum of five pounds current Money of Virginia to be paid by the said Benjamin Beul at or before the sealing or Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Richard Beul of Mary do hereby Acknowledge & thereof from warrant part or parcel thereof do hereby fully & freely Acquit & Discharge the said Benjamin Beul of themselves their heirs to be fully Satisfied Contented & have granted bargained sold Aliened Expressed & by these presents do give grant bargain sell Aliened Express confirm to the said Benjamin Beul his heirs & Assigns for ever one certain Tract or parcel of Land Consisting by Estimation Eighty Acres bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a pine & birch tree of Anthony Lewis Land then by his Line south by four degrees East ninety six poles to a White Oak by a Run side a corner of Mr. Johnsons Land then by his Line south sixty degrees East seventy nine poles to the corner
