This Indenture made the 9th Day of August in the Year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred & fifty seven Between George Williams of the One Part, and John Oney of the Other Part Witnesseth that the said George Williams his Heirs and Assigns by these presents have given granted Bargained sold Ceded bestowed and confirmed and by these presents do give grant Bargain and sell and confirm unto the said John Oney his Heirs & Assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land Lying and being on the West side of Metherin River in the County of Southampton being Part of a Patent granted to Robert Bryan which Patent was dated the 12th Day of January 1747 to wit Beginning at a pine corner tree Epaphroditus Williams from thence Lucy Clifes woodard to the trace path branch to a Gum upon the said Branch to Poplar from thence to Pine in the Mery branch down the said branch to a corner tree of the said Epaphroditus Williams again down a Sprong of Branches called the Little swamp to the beginning Extending One hundred Acres more or Less with every part thereof and also all the certain Right title Interest Claim or Demand whatsoever of him the said George Williams of in or to the same Premises Part thereof to have & to hold and every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said John Oney his Heirs & Assigns to the only proper Use and benefit of the said John Oney for himself his Heirs & Assigns forever the said Land and Premises and every Part thereof agt himself and his Heirs and against all and every other Person and Persons whatsoever unto the said John Oney his Heirs and Assigns shall and well warrant and forever Defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Williams and Oney hath hereunto set his hand and fixed his Seal the day and Year first above Written.
