Johnson This Indenture made the Eleventh day of August in the thirty first year of the Reign of His Majesty our Sovereign Lord George the Second and in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and fifty seven BETWEEN Jacob Johnson of Southampton County in Virginia and Mary his wife of the One Part and Henry Johnson of the County and Colony Aforesaid of the Other Part Witnesses that the said Jacob Johnson & Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eighty pounds Current money to them in hand paid by the said Henry Johnson at or before the Creating and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof the said Jacob Johnson and Mary his wife doth hereby Acknowledge they the said Jacob Johnson & Mary his wife hath Granted Bargained and Sold Alien Enfeoffed & Confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant Bargain and Sell Alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Henry Johnson his heirs and Assigns forever a certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing by Estimation Two Hundred Acres to the same more or less Situate and being in Southampton County Bounded as followeth Viz^t Beginning at the Mouth of a Branch on Nottoway River below the Indian field so up the said Branch to a Red Line of the Parents to a Pine tree along the Patten Line south thirty six Degrees East to a Red Oak thence down a Line N. E. to Nottoway River so up the said River to the first Station the said Land being part of a Patent formerly granted to William Scott by the Honble. Alexander Spotswood Lieut Governor and Commander in Chief of the Colony and Dominion of Virginia Bearing Date the sixteenth Day of June one thousand seven hundred & fourteen and also all Trees
