Phillips doth hereby acknowledge Hath granted bargained sold aliened
enjoyed and confirmed and by these Presents Doth grant bargain
sell alien enjoy and confirm unto the said Benjamin Holden his Heirs
and Assigns forever all that Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being
in the Parish of Nottoway in the County of Southampton formerly sold
