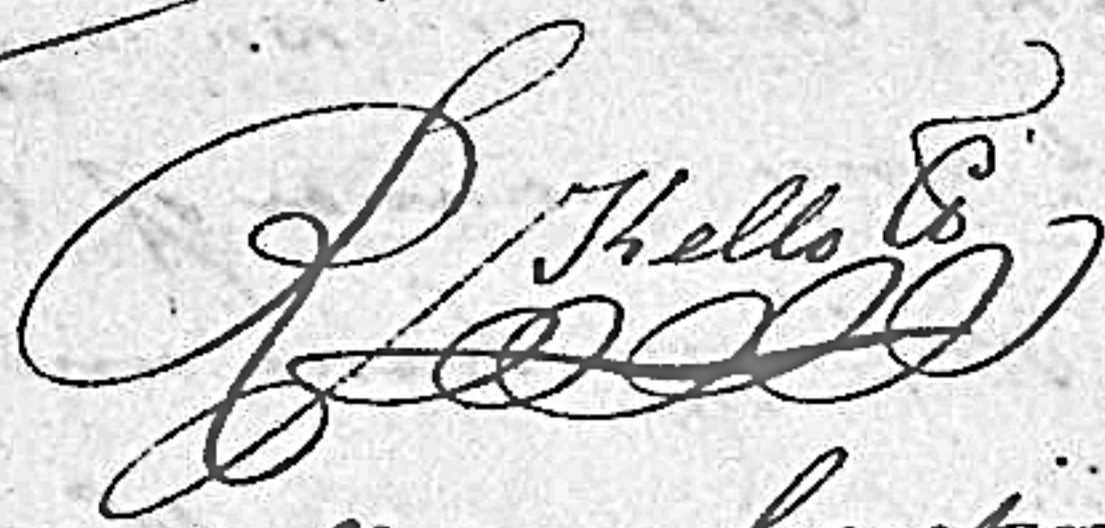

To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting Know ye that I James Jones of the Parish of Nottoway in the County of Southampton for and in Consideration of the Love good will and Affection which I have and do bear towards my loving Son Anselm Jones of the Parish and County aforesaid have given and granted and by these Presents do give and grant unto the said Anselm Jones to him Heirs and Assigns forever Two certain Tracts or Parcels of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton Containing by Estimation three Hundred Acres more or less one hundred whereof being conveyed by John Jordan to the said James Jones Beginning at a Gum a corner Tree of Robert Harts Land Thence by the said Harts Lines a South Course to a Branch then up the various Courses of the Run of the said Branch to a Pine marked in the Head of the said Branch Thence a South Course by a Line of New marked Trees to a white Oak a marked Tree in the aforesaid Line thence along the said Line a South Course to a White Oak a corner Tree in the said Land then West by South one hundred and twenty one Poles to a Pine then North West by North seventy six Poles to a Maple by the side of the South Fork of the Lightwood Swamp and down the various Courses

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
