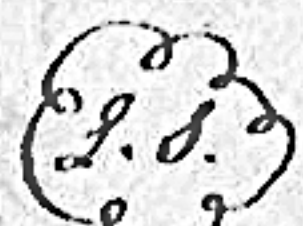
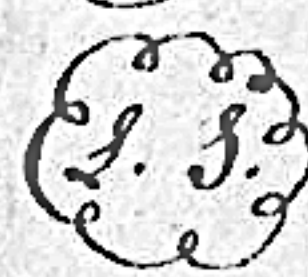

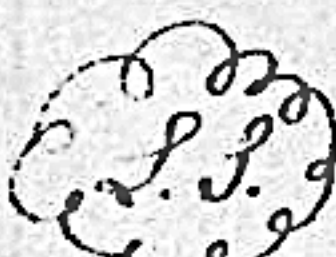

This Indenture made the seventh Day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight Between James Wright of the County of Southampton of the one Part and William Corner of the said County of the other Part Witnesseth that the said James Wright for and in Consideration of the Sum of eighty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in Hand paid by the said William Corner at or before the sealing and Delivery of These Presents the Receipt whereof the said James Wright doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith to be fully satisfied and paid and thereof doth clearly acquit and discharge the said William Corner his Heirs Executors and Administrators forever by these Presents Hath given granted bargained sold enfeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents doth give Grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Corner his Heirs and Assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing by Estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County
