This Indenture made this eighth Day of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight Between Henry Pope of Virginia and County of Southampton of the one Part and James Pope of the same County of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Henry Pope for and in Consideration of the Sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money to him in Hand paid at or before the executing and Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said James Pope thereof he the said Henry Pope doth hereby acquit and discharge hath granted bargained sold and by these Presents doth fully and absolutely grant bargain sell enfeoff release and confirm unto the said James Pope his Heirs and assigns one certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in Southampton County on the South Side of Nottoway River containing by Estimation one hundred and fifty Acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth Beginning at a Black Oak standing near the Road that leads from Flowers's Bridge on Nottoway River to Crossfords Bridge on Meherrin then running along William Poper's Line to John Howell Edmund's Corner Tree a Turkey Oak then along Colonel Edmund's Line to a Lightwood Stump standing near the Road called the Chappell Road then down the said Chappell Road to Flowers's Road then down the said Flowers's Road to the Beginning Together with all Houses and Building thereon with the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and Profits thereof and every Part and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances To have and to hold all and singular the said Land above mentioned and every Part and Parcel thereof unto the said James Pope his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Pope for himself his Heirs Executors and Administrators the said Land and Premises and every Part thereof against all and every other Person or Persons whatsoever to the said James Pope his Heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever Defend by these Presents In Witness whereof the said Henry Pope hath hereunto set his Hand and affixed his Seal the Day and Year above Written
