This Indenture made this twenty fourth Day of February one thousand seven
hundred and fifty eight and in the thirty first year of the reign of our
Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain
France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between Philip
Brantley and Mary his Wife of Norway Parish and County of Southampton
of the one Part and John Brantley of the Parish and County aforesaid of the
other Part Witnesseth that the said Philip Brantley and Mary his Wife
for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty two Pounds fifteen Shillings
current Money of Virginia to them in Hand Paid by the said John
Brantley at or before the Envealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt
whereof the said Philip Brantley and Mary his Wife doth hereby
acknowledge that the said Philip Brantley and Mary his Wife hath granted
bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these Presents doth
grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said John
Brantley his Heirs and Assigns forever a certain Parcel of Land where he
the said Philip now liveth which the said Philip bought of one John
Lewis in the Year one thousand seven hundred and fifty two Containing by
Estimation one hundred Acres more or less situated lying and being in
the Parish and County aforesaid and bounded as followeth to wit
beginning at a live Oak in Antony's Delight and running up the
Delight to a Pine a corner Tree in the said Land then running an
East course to a Gum standing in a Branch that makes out of the
said Delight then down the said Branch to the Mouth of the spring
Branch then up the spring Branch to a Pine standing in a bounding
Line between the said Land and the Land of James Peadons then along
the said Line to a Gum from thence to the live Oak aforesaid for one
hundred Acres of Land be the same more or less And also all Trees
Woods Underwoods commons of Pasture Profits Commodities Advantages
Emoluments and Hereditaments whatsoever to the said Land
abovementioned belonging or in anywise appertaining or in or upon
the same growing happening or arising and also the Reversion
