 to the said John Phillips his Heirs Executors Administrators or
 Assigns from henceforth to him and their own proper Use and as his
 and their own proper Goods so absolutely without any Manner of
 Condition I the said Thomas Phillips have set and put my
 Hand and Seal this seventeenth Day of October in the Year
 of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and fifty seven

 unto the said James Jones his Executors Administrators & Assigns to his
 and their own proper Use and Uses forever and I the said Matthew
 Parkham do Warrant all and every one of the aforesaid Slaves to the
 said James Jones his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns
 against all Persons do Warrant and do forever Defend In Witness
 whereof I the said Matthew Parkham have hereunto set my
 Hand and affixed my Seal the Day and Year first above written
