This Indenture made this eighth Day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and fifty eight. Between Robert Vick of Virginia and County of
Southampton of the one Part and Simon Vick of the same County of the other Part
Witnesseth that the said Robert Vick for and in Consideration of the Sum of
twelve Pound Current Money to him in Hand paid at or before the executing and Delivery
hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Simon Vick thereof
he the said Robert Vick doth hereby acquit and Discharge Both Granted Bargained
Sole effected Released and Confirmed and by these Presents doth fully and absolutely
Grant Bargain Sell Enfeoff Release and Confirm unto him the said Simon
Vick his Heir and Assigns one certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and
being in Southampton County on the South side of Nottoway River containing
by Estimation one hundred Acres be the same more or less and bounded as
followeth to wit Beginning at a White Oak Sapling standing in the
pinney Meadow then running along the Patent Line to the Little Swamp
Then North two Degrees West seventy four Pole to a Maple then North
eighty five Degrees West one hundred and five Pole to a White Oak Sapling
Then along the Patent Line to the Dividing Line between the said Simon
Vicks own Land and the said Robert Vicks Land then down the Dividing
Line to the Beginning and also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder
and Remainders Rent Issues and Profits thereof and every Part and Parcel
thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand
whatsoever of the said Robert Vick of in and to the said Land and Premises
and every Part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said Land
above mentioned and every Part and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances
to him the said Simon Vick his Heir and Assigns for ever and the said
Robert Vick for himself his Heir Executors and Administrators the said
Land and Premises and every Part thereof against all and every other
Person and Persons whatsoever to the said Simon Vick his Heir and Assigns
shall and will warrant and forever defend by these Presents In Witness
