County of Southampton the Fee simple Estate of and in a certain Chace or Piece of Land
lying and being in the aforesaid Parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton containing
by Estimation four hundred and fifty Acres be the name more or less And Whereas the
said Hannah cannot conveniently travel to our Court of our said County to make acknowledgements
of the said Conveyance Therefore We do give unto you or any two or more of you power to receive
the acknowledgment which the said Hannah shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance
aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereunto annexed And we do therefore
command you that you do personally go to the said Hannah and receive her acknowledgments
of the same and examine her privily and apart from the said Henry her Husband whether
she doth the same freely and voluntarily without his persuasions or threats? and whether
she be willing the same should be recorded in the Court of our said County? And when you have
received her acknowledgments and examined her as aforesaid that you do distinctly and openly
certify us thereof in our said Court under your Seals sending therewith the said Indenture and
