 Bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Jacob Barnes one Woman Slave named
 Hannah To have and to hold the said Negro to him the said Jacob Barnes
 his Heirs and Assigns to use or their proper use in behoof forever and the said
 Richard Vick for my self my Heirs and Assigns and every of us the said Negro unto
 the said Jacob Barnes his Heirs and Assigns and against all other persons whatsoever shall
 and will warrant and forever Defend by these presents at any time hereafter that
 that may lay Claim challenge or Demand to the said Negro by any way or means whatsoever In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and for use affixed my seal this twentieth Day of
 October 1758
