Sebrell & Daniel Sebrell of the County of Southampton for & in Consideration of the
Love, good Will & affection which we have & do bear towards our loving brother
Benjamin Sebrell of the County aforesaid hath given & granted & by these presents do
freely give & grant unto the said Benjamin Sebrell to him his heirs or assigns all our right & Title
of a certain Tract or parcell of Land containing by Estimation one hundred & fifty acres being the same
whereon the said Benjamin Sebrell now Dwells & given by the Last will & Testament of Samuel Sebrell
Deceased to be Equally divided between his Sons Jo^{seph} Sebrell & Benjamin Sebrell the whole one hundred
& fifty acres Included within the following Bounds Beginning at a large turkey Oak on Nathaniel
Davis Line thence along the said Davis Line to the old Indian Line thence along the old Indians Line
to a deep branch thence up the said deep branch to a maple thence up a prong of the said deep branch
to a pine then along a line of market trees to a small branch thence down the said branch to the beginning
also all woods water & water Courses profit Commodities & advantages what soever to the same
belonging or in any wise appertaining & also the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rent
& Services to the only proper use & behoof of the said Benjamin Sebrell his heirs & assigns for ever &
the said Samuel Sebrell & Daniel Sebrell for themselves their heirs do Covenant & agree the above mentioned
Land with the Appurtenances thereunto belonging against themselves their heirs & against all & every
person or persons whatsoever to the said Benjamin Sebrell his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & defend
absolutely without any other Manner of Condition in Witness hereof we have hereunto set our hands
