 fifty eight Between Joshua Vick of Southampton County of the one part & Elizabeth Farecloth of the
 County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Vick for & in consideration of the
 sum of five shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Farecloth
 the receipt whereof the said Joshua Vick hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold aliened
 Enjoined & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the said
 Elizabeth Farecloth her heirs Lawfully Begotten of her Body for a parcel of land lying in Southampton
 County aforesaid & being part of a patten granted to Richard Vick Sen^r & bearing date the Twelfth day of
 January one thousand seven hundred & forty seven & bounded as followeth to wit. Beginning at a pine & a corner
 Tree then South South East one hundred & seventy four poles to a white Oak & South forty degrees East fifty two
 poles to a red oak sapling in To Barnes Line thence by the said Barnes's line South twenty degrees west on a
 hundred & four poles to a white oak by the side of the Cyprus Swamp aforesaid thence up the various courses
 of the run of the said swamp to a pine & a corner made by the side of the Cyprus Swamp aforesaid thence by
 a line of marked Trees growing to the beginning with all woods underwoods Common & Pasture profits
 Commodities advantages Emblements & heridaments whatsoever to the plantation or parcel of land
