Benjamin Bradshaw of the parish of Nottoway & County of Southampton of the one part and Moses Joyner of the same County & parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Moses Joyner for and in consideration of the sum of twenty nine pounds Current Money of Virginia to the said Moses Joyner in hand paid by the said Benjamin Bradshaw at or before the Insealing & Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Moses Joyner do acknowledge and thereof acquit and Discharge the said Benjamin Bradshaw hath granted Bargained sold all and Enjoined & confirmed and by these presents do grant Bargain & sell all and Enjoined & confirm unto the said Benjamin Bradshaw to his heirs & assigns forever - A Certain tract or Parcel of land situate lying & being in the aforesaid Parish of Nottoway & County of Southampton on the South side of Round Hill Swamp containing Three Hundred acres of Land part of a patent of Three Hundred & Ninety Acres granted to the said Benjamin Bradshaw bearing Date the Tenth Day of September one Thousand Seven hundred and Fifty six then Conveyed by the said Benjamin Bradshaw to the said Moses Joyner

with all and singular the said Land & premises with the Appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Bradshaw his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said Benjamin Bradshaw his heirs & assigns forever of the said Moses Joyner his heirs Executors & Admitors doth Covenant promise & Grant to & with the said Benjamin Bradshaw his heirs & assigns that the said Moses Joyner his heirs their Tract or parcel of Land with the Appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Bradshaw his heirs & assigns Against the Title Claim or Demand of himself his heirs or any person or persons whatsoever claiming by form or under him shall & will forever warrant & Defend by these presents Witness whereof the said Moses Joyner hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the Day & Year above Written.
