This Indenture made this seventh day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & tyne Between Joseph Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife of the County of Sussex of one part & James Ridley Junr of the County of Southampton of the other part Witneseth that the said Joseph Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James Ridley Junr the Rec't whereof the said Jos Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife have granted Bargained Sold & Doth by these presents grant Bargain & Sell unto the said James Ridley Junr his heirs and assigns forever one certain Tractor parcel of land lying & being in Southampton County aforesaid on the south side of the Three Creeks containing by estimation One hundred & eighty acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth Beginning at a Gum on the west side Halls Branch thence west by south one hundred poles to four trees chapt inwards near a small Branch thence South <sup>West</sup> eighty three degrees ninety one pole to a Hickory thence south by east one hundred & sixty eight poles to a Spanish Oak then east Ninety one pole to an oak then east by North Sixty four poles to a oak by the side of Halls Branch aforesaid up the various Courses of the Run of the said Branch to the beginning And houses outhouses outhouses Edifices Building orchards gardens Woods under Woods Trees Ways water Course profits Commodities Hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining And the Reversion & Revertions Remainders & Remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof of all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of them the said Jos Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife of in & to the same & every part & parcel thereof With the appurtenances & all Deeds Evidences & Writings touching or in any wise concerning the same To have & to hold all & singular the said land & premises unto the said Jos Ridley Junr his heirs & assigns To the only proper use & behoof him his heirs & assigns forever & the said Jos Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife for them selves their Heirs Executors & Administrators doth Covenant & Grant to & with the said Jos Ridley Junr his heirs & assigns forever by these presents that they the said Jos Thorpe & Elizabeth his Wife & their heirs aforesaid Tractor parcel of land & premises unto the said Jos Ridley Junr his heirs & assigns against all & every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same shall be will warre & forever defend by these presents provided nevertheless it is hereby agreed that John Buffin shall have the privilege for his Indigo Works joining to & upon the said lands always giving him by the said Thorpe (now) convenient earth for raising & repairing the Dam from time to time with liberty to fall any tree that shall shade the pond or water to the free use of the shelter house & other necessary conveniences In witness whereof the said Jos Elizabeth his Wife hath hereunto set her hands & affixed their seals the Day and year first above written ~~~~~
