This Indenture made the Eleventh day of October in the Thirtieth year of the Reign of our
Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the
Faith &c. Anno 1759 Between George Collier & Jane Collier his wife of the parish of Newport & County of Isle
of Wight & William Norman of the County of Nansemond of the one part & Benjamin Worrell of the parish
of Nottoway & County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that for & in Consideration of the Just
Sum of Thirty five pounds Current money of Virginia by the said Benjamin Worrell to wth the said
George Collier & Jane his wife & William Norman well & truly in hand paid at or before the Executing &
Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge & thereof & every part & parcel
thereof acquit & discharge the said Benjamin Worrell his ^{heirs} Executors & Administrators by these presents
he the said George Collier & Jane his wife & Wm Norman hath given granted bargained sold Enfeoffed &
Confirmed & these presents doth fully & clearly & absolutely give grant bargain sell Alien Enfeoff &
confirm unto the said Benjn Worrell his heirs & assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing
Four hundred Acres more or less lying & being in the County of Southampton on the South side of
Nottoway River on both sides of the Lynnhurst Swamp it being a tract of Land which one Arthur
Washington did enter & take up by a Patent bearing date the tenth day of March one thousand
Seven hundred & fifty nine & sold his right & Title of the said Land to the aforesaid George Collier &
Wm Norman & patented in their name the said Land is Bounded as followeth (To wit) Beginning
at a Black Oak a corner of Wm Vick Junr's Land thence north forty one Degrees West one
Hundred & Seventy six poles to a gum in the Lynnhurst Swamp thence down the said Swamp north forty
six Degrees East forty poles to a gum thence North Seventy two Degrees West fifty eight poles to a
White Oak thence South Twenty four Degrees West one hundred & seventy five poles to a White Oak
thence South Thirty Degrees East two hundred & eighteen poles to a Turkey Oak thence South
