This Indenture made the tenth day of October in the thirty third year of the reign of our
Lynn
Sovereign lord George the second by the grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King defender
of the faith etc Anno 1750 Between John Loyd & Mary Loyd his wife of the parish of Nolloway
& County of Southampton of the one part & William Lankford of the parish of Newport & County of
Isle of Wight of the other part witnesseth that for & in consideration of the just sum of fifteen Pounds current
Money of Virginia by the said Wm Lankford to the said John Loyd & Mary his wife well & truly in
hand paid all & before the unsealing & delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof we hereby acknowledge
the receipt whereof part & parcel thereof Acquit & forgo to discharge the said William Lankford his heirs
executors & administrators by these presents to the said John Loyd & Mary his wife hath given granted bargained
sold in full confirmed by these presents doth fully clearly & absolutely give grant Bargain sell alien
In full & confirm unto the said Wm Lankford his heirs & assigns forever One hundred & Sixty Two Acres
of land it being the lower part of the tract of land wherein the said John Loyd now liveth it being that
part of land whereof Abraham Johnson formerly lived in the fork of Blackwater & no head swamp &c
Bounded as followeth (towt) Beginning at a cyprus standing on ^{the side of the} Blackwater thence north forty Degrees
west Twenty nine pole to a gum Standing in the said John Loyd a spring branch thence down the run
of the said Branch about fifteen pole in a Direct ^{line} to a gum in the sd Branch thence north Thirty nine
Degrees west twenty three pole to a Red oak corner thence north Seventeen Degrees east one hundred &
Twenty pole to a Stake thence north forty five Degrees West to a black gum standing in the no head
swamp thence down the run of the no head swamp & several course thereof to black water River
thence up the said River to the beginning place now this said Land in these bounds abovementioned
which the said Wm Lankford has purchased of John Loyd & Mary his wife being scant of
Timber the said John Loyd & Mary gives the said Wm Lankford free liberty to range all over
their land for any kind of timber which the said Wm Lankford wants for his plantation we now the said
John Loyd & Mary his wife have sold the said Wm Lankford this Land in these bounds abovementioned
Together with all wood underwood way water water courses & embankments & appurtenances whatsoever
to the said piece or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining And the reversion & reverions
remainder & remainders of all & singular the before mentioned premises or any part or parcel thereof & all
the estate right title interest property claim & demand whatsoever of them the said John Loyd & Mary his wife
of in unto the same I have & to hold the said piece or parcel of land & all & singular other the premises hereby granted
Bargained & sold remised or released with their & every of their rights members & appurtenances whatsoever
the said Wm Lankford his heirs & assigns to the only profit & use of him
the said Wm Lankford his heirs & assigns forever & to the said John Loyd & Mary his wife for the uses & intent
the said piece or parcel of land & all & singular other the premises before granted bargained & sold in
with the appurtenances unto the said Wm Lankford & his heirs to the only profit & use of the said John Loyd & Mary his wife
& assigns forever against them the said John Loyd & Mary his wife & all & every other person or persons whatsoever are
fully claiming by from or under the name of them shall be will warrant & forever defend by the present & the said
