This Indenture made this fourteenth day of February one thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty Between John Oney of Southampton of the one part & William Bryant Junr of the same County in Virginia. Witnesseth that for the in consideration of the sum of eight pounds & pence in hand paid by the said William Bryant being fully satisfied & contented to hereby acquit & discharge the said William Bryant his heirs & assigns & by these presents have given granted bargain sold & aliened & confirmed & by these presents do give grant bargain sell & confirm unto the said William Bryant his heirs & assigns a certain parcel of Land lying & being on the North side of Notoway River in the County aforesaid being part of a tract in a patent granted to Robert Bryant by his honorable Governor William Gooch bearing date the 12 day of January 1744 to wit beginning at a pine a corner tree of the said William from thence along by Oliver Woodwards to the back path Branch to a gum then up the said Branch to a poplar from thence to a pine in the Mirey Branch then down the said Branch to a corner tree of the aforesaid the said William to a gum then down a prong of a branch called the Little swamp to the beginning including one hundred Acres more or less with every part thereof and also the Estate right title Interest claim or Demand whatsoever of them the said John Oney or to the same premises & every part thereof to have & to hold & every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said William Bryant his heirs & assigns forever the said Land & premises & every part thereof against himself & his heirs & against every other person & persons whatsoever unto the said William Bryant his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents in witness whereof the said John Oney hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & Date first above Written
