This Indenture made this nineteenth day of November anno Domini one Thousand  
seven Hundred & fifty nine Between William Sawrey Junr of the County of Nobbs in province of  
North Carolina of the one part & John Hines of the County of Southampton in Virginia of the other  
part Witnesseth that the said William Sawrey Junr for & in consideration of the sum of one Hun-  
dred pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the In sealing & Delivery  
of these presents the receipt of which he himself fully satisfied contented & paid he doth hereby  
Acknowledge hath granted & sold alliened & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant  
bargains sell allien & confirm unto the said John Hines his heirs & assigns forever a certain  
Tract or parcel of Land containing two Hundred & fifteen acres lying & being in the County of  
Southampton on the west side of the Asamoofock swamp & bounded as per a plat surveyed  
for William Sawrow the eighth day of February 1744 the said Land was purchased by the said  
Sawrow of the Chiefs men of the Yalloway Indians Nation as may appear by a Deed from the said  
Chiefs men of the aforesaid Nation to the said Sawrey & recorded in the Court of the Col of right  
also all woods underwoods ways water water courses & with all the profits commodities and  
advantages whatsoever to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining & also the reversion and  
reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents & Services of the said premises & every part thereof & also  
all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim & Demand whatsoever of him the said William Sawrey Junr  
of in & to the same premises & every part thereof To have & to hold all & singular the said premis  
above mentioned & every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Hines his  
heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of him the said John Hines his heirs & assigns forever  
& the said William Sawrey Junr for himself & his heirs & the above mentioned premises to every  
part thereof against him & his heirs & against all & every other person & persons claiming from  
by or under him the said John Hines his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend  
by these presents In witness whereof the said William Sawrey hath hereunto put his  
hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written
