This Indenture made this Thirteenth of March In the year of our Lord God one
 Thousand seven hundred & Sixty Between George Cornett of the Parish of Allemare & County
 of Suffex of the one part & Joel Cornett of the parish & County aforesaid son of the said George Cornett
 of the other part Witneseth that the said George Cornett for & in consideration of the Natural
 Love & Affection which he hath & bears unto the said Joel Cornett & for the better Maintenance
 of him the said Joel Cornett hath given granted aliened Enfeoffed & Confirmed by these presents
 Both give grant alien Enfeoff & Confirm unto the said Joel Cornett his heirs & assigns a certain Tract or
 parcel of Land lying & being in the Parish of Nottoeay a County of Southampton on the south
 side of the Hornet swamp containing one hundred & Seventy acres both the same more or less and
 Bounded as followeth (beginning at a Spanish oak on the North side of the Hornet swamp w/
 corner of the said Cornetts other land thence south twenty five Degrees last crossing the said
 swamp fourteen poles to a pine in a corner of Charles Mabrys land thence by the said Mabrys line
 the same course twenty nine poles to a Red oak thence south five Degrees west one hundred & Thirty poles
 to a Red oak in Joseph Horwoods line thence by the said Horwoods line North seventy Degrees west
 Sixty eight pole to a Stockery saplin in the County Line then by the County line North Sixty
 Degrees East one hundred & three poles to a light wood post in the said Cornetts other land thence
 by his own old line North eighty five Degrees last ninety poles to a poplar over the Run of the
 Hornet swamp aforesaid & down the various courses of the said swamp to the Beginning and all
 and singular the houses Difices Buildings Barns stables orchards woods under woods water &
